month. You will receive a Pension Payment Confirmation Statement every month. Following that, you will only receive a statement each January or if there is a change to your payment amount.

- 1 Payment Date indicates the date your pension payment was deposited to your account.
- 2 Current Month amounts are for one month only; the current month as of the Payment Date.
- 3 Year To Date amounts provide a running total to Payment Date for the current calendar year.
- 4 Basic Pension is the gross basic lifetime pension.
- 5 Bridge Pension is the bridge benefit payable to age 65. If you are not eligible for a bridge pension this will not appear on your statement.
- 6 Total Gross Pension is the total payment amount before deductions.
- 7 Income Tax is deducted according to the federal and provincial tax rates. If you wish to have additional income tax deducted from your pension payment, you can submit your request to SHEPP through a letter or email or by completing a new Federal Tax Form (TD1) and submitting it to SHEPP.
- 8 Group Life Insurance premium. This benefit is optional and will not appear on your statement if you did not elect to continue coverage. Contact 3sHealth with any and all questions regarding Group Life Insurance.
- 9 Total Deductions is the total amount of all deductions.
- 10 Net Pension is equal to Total Gross Pay minus Total Deductions.
